SUSTAINABILITY COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

May 1, 2018 - 6:00 P.M.

- 1) Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 6:05 p.m.
- 2) Roll Call: Eleanor Pardini, Nancy Schick, Jonathan Spencer and Andrew Wilson. Staff present: Brian Herr.
- 3) Approval of meeting minutes from April 3, 2018: Jonathan Spencer motioned to approve, seconded by Andrew Wilson and all were in favor.
- 4) Public Comment: None.
- 5) New Business: Public Works Director Anthony Traxler stopped by to answer questions. Eleanor Pardini asked about the city's recycling program. Anthony mentioned grants are available to provide recycling for apartment complexes not currently provided with recycling. Currently the city pays for recycling thru a grant for apartment buildings with twelve units and less. Anthony stated that the city could approach some of the larger complexes such as Sunnen Station Apartments with 174 units about starting a recycling program. Jonathan Spencer asked about the native plant display at the aquatic center. Anthony mentioned that the city applied for a park planning grant and has been approved for planning services to design a splash park at the pool and the native plant display on the west side of the aquatic center. Barry Greenberg mentioned some detail relating to two projects that have been discussed. Ameren UE has been approached about vehicle charging stations. Also some green areas or native plant displays associated with the Great Rivers Greenway bike path project were planned.
