

**CITY COUNCIL
WORK SESSION MINUTES
AUGUST 13, 2019**

The City Council Work Session was called to order at 6:05 p.m. by Mayor Greenberg. The following elected officials were present: Councilmember Wood, Councilmember Phillips, Councilmember Pardini, Councilmember Crader, Councilmember Faulkingham and Councilmember Schmidt. Members of the Great Rivers Greenway staff displayed a PowerPoint presentation outlining the Deer Creek intersection study. This study reviewed the 3 intersections located along the proposed Deer Creek Greenway extension which connects Deer Creek Greenway through Maplewood connecting with the River Des Peres Greenway in the City of St. Louis. The 3 intersections studied were Big Bend/Oxford, Greenwood/Sutton and Greenwood/Marshall/Canterbury. Three options for each intersection were presented. Various councilmembers asked questions during the presentation.

At the end of the presentation, Susan Trautman, Chief Executive Officer of Great Rivers Greenway, reminded the Council that they would not spend any more money on this project until there is agreement on the design of the project, the cost of the project and where the funding for the project will come from.

The Work Session adjourned at 7:10 p.m.
